

Rev. Fr. Clifford Tremblay was pastor from 1992- 2007. He made many spiritual and physical changes to the parish. He promoted hospitality and stood at the entrance for all Masses and welcomed everyone by name with a handshake or a hug if you preferred. We acquired one of the first permanent Deacons (Ed Mcleod) in the Diocese and had the first Parish Administrator (Barb Slack) in the Prince Albert Deanery. The wall between the entrance and the nave was fitted with the large glass windows and doors. The entrance doors were also glass and side windows installed. This made the area bright and welcoming. The basement, too, was remodelled. Thanks to the generosity of parishioners, the financial loans were paid off in record time.






