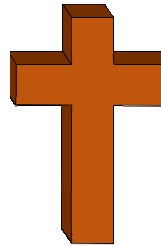

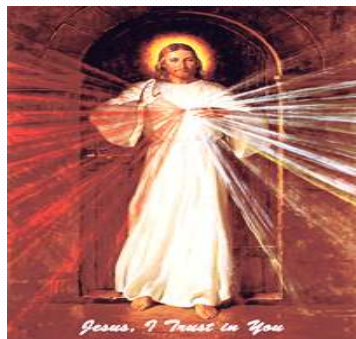

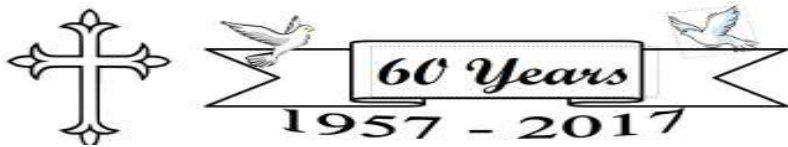

A Memory

My father Marjan and my mother Anna Ruskowski became members of St. Mark Parish in 1947. They were members of St. Mary Parish just east of Prince Albert; but in the Prince Albert Diocese. They were Polish and Fr. Raczynski spoke Polish. We celebrated a Polish Mass every Sunday. Our family raised turkeys for the turkey bingos St. Mark held as fundraisers. My mother baked lots of bread for the bake sales and cooked many roasters of cabbage rolls for various suppers and banquets. She also grew flowers to decorate the church. Both my parents worked at the food hall at the fairgrounds. My father Marjan sang in the Polish choir for years and at Christmas I would go with my father and the choir to sing carols in the rural areas. We sang English, Polish and Ukrainian depending on where we stopped. When we were done we would return home with all the singers, my mother would have a full course meal waiting for them.

My family including Uncles, Aunts, brothers and sisters have belonged to St. Mark Parish. The legacy of two devoted and faithful people continues to live on in their descendants who thrive on the inspiration of their faith community of St. Mark.

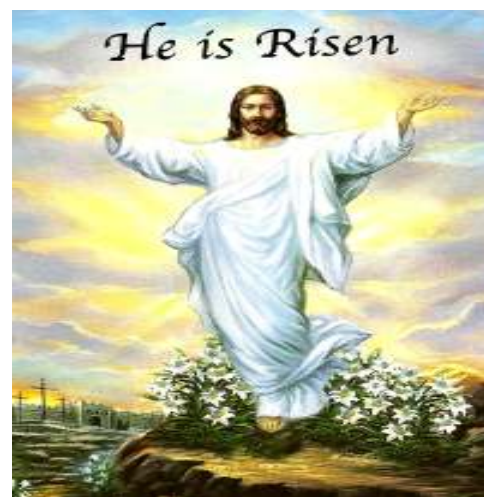
