It can be given to express joy and/or best wishes. *The action may be: a Rosary, Holy Hour, Days of Fasting, Act of Charity, Special Novenas, or any other spiritual action.*

We will have a card that you can add your spiritual bouquet to in the entrance of the church on the next few Sundays. It is our hope that Kendrick will keep these bouquets close to his heart for the rest of his life

June 13 Feast Day of St. Anthony of Padua

St. Anthony, at age 15 joined the Canons Regular of Saint Augustine; and later the Franciscans Order. He studied intently; and was sent to preach and teach throughout Italy to Bologna and Padua. The power of his words converted many. He died at age 36 and was canonized the next year by Pope Gregory IX. St. Anthony is typically depicted with a book and the infant Child Jesus and is commonly referred to as the *"finder of lost articles."*

Today's Gospel, Jesus says " *Whoever does the will of God is my brother and sister and mother.*"




Do you know why Jesus said that?
