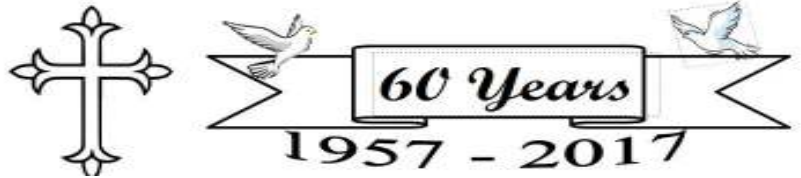
MAY - Month of Mary
