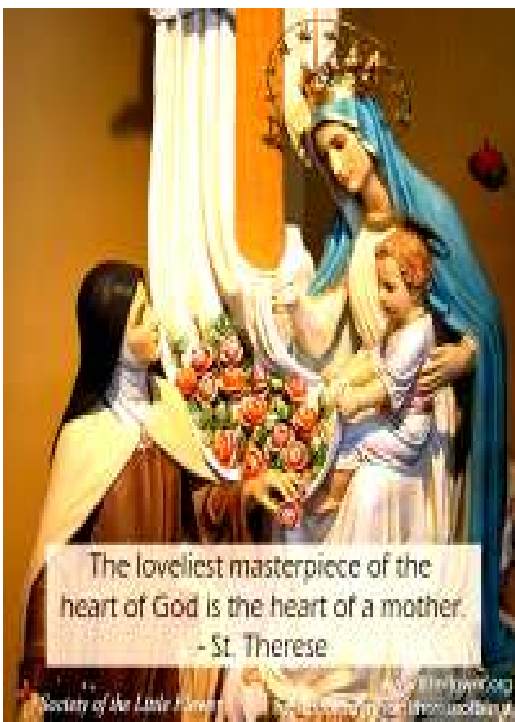

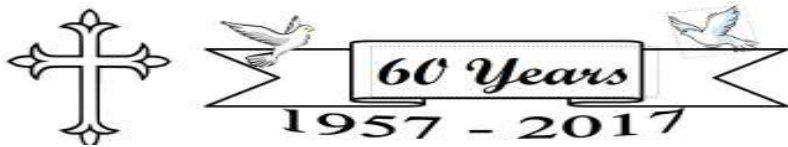

As I loved my grandmother I decided I would still go to church but just use it as a reflection and social time. When the Creed came up at the St. Mark's Mass, I refused to say it. That decision stayed with me for years.

I hope no one minds, but now when we say the Creed I do so with extra enthusiasm and a smile on my face. 
