



# **Vocation Corner** Thirty - second Sunday of the Year - B

**A Vocation View:** Honest, dedicated people. Jesus is looking for dedicated and humble people who will give the best they have in response to His call to service. Give what you've got when you are called.

**Prayer:** That those called to proclaim the Kingdom of God as priests, deacons and consecrated religious, will be generous in serving Christ by deepening their trust in God's providence, we pray to the Lord.

Action: "COMMUNITY" describes the life religious brothers and sisters choose. Community enables the individual to reach out to others with the strength and courage that comes from knowing, "I don't have to do it alone. Others stand with me in this. My abilities are complemented by their gifts, confidence, wisdom and vision." In community, sisters and brothers live out their vowed commitments, knowing that, though each member is unique, the binding force in life is each one's personal and communal relationship with Jesus.

Father Claude Giguère served in our diocese for many years. He retired in 2001 due to ill health and returned to live with his family. He passed away on Oct 29 from cancer. His funeral will be held Nov 10 in Waterloo, Quebec. A special Memorial Mass will be celebrated at Sacred Heart Cathedral on Nov 23 at 7:00 p.m. Refreshments to follow. May he rest in peace.

What is a "Mass Stipend"? It is an offering given to a priest by an individual or a group so that he may say Mass for the donor's intention. This offering is usually a sum of money. Does this person buy the Mass? By no means! No amount of money can buy the Mass. Rather it is an expression of the donor's desire to share in the fruits of the Mass. The origin of this practice goes back to the early centuries of the Church. The faithful brought bread, wine and other gifts to the Mass. Some of the bread and wine was used during the celebration and what remained was used for the support of the clergy and the poor. Traces of this appear in (I Cor. 11:17 ff.) Has the practice changed today? Not very much, except it is now usually customary to offer a stipend. The practice of Mass Stipends is regulated by Cannon Law (945-958). Canon 945 states, "The faithful who make an offering so that Mass can be celebrated for their intention, contribute to the good of the Church, and by that offering they share in the Church's concern for the support of its ministers and its activities."

<u>NOTE</u>: A few years ago, to reflect the present economic situation, the diocese has increased the suggested offer to \$10.00. As your parish priest I encourage you to use this opportunity to pray for those who are in need. During the month of November, we often remember those who have died. You may offer a Mass *In Memory of a Loved One* who has died, to pray for someone who is ill; to celebrate a joyful occasion or offer a Mass in thanksgiving for blessing received Keeping track of scheduling Masses and Mass stipends can be a bit of a chore. Fr. Jim has asked Darsey (the parish secretary) to handle the scheduling. If you would like to offer a Mass for someone you love, please contact Fr. Jim or Darsey.


