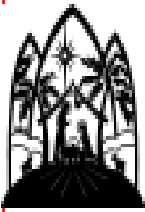

**VOCATIONS CORNER:**

**Thirty-second Sunday in Ordinary Time – A**

**A Vocation View:** We usually put a great amount of preparation into big events like weddings, anniversaries and parties of all kinds. We should prepare ourselves even more for the final banquet in the Kingdom of Heaven!

**Prayer:** That those called to serve the Lord and His people as priests, deacons and in the consecrated life will be blessed with holy zeal in their prayers and in their ministry, we pray to the Lord.

**Action:** LAST THINGS FIRST - at various times in the year, the Church reminds us that there will be an end to our lives and that there will be an account of how we have lived. Do you live with those last things in mind?

As the Christmas season approaches, the generosity of people increases. **Development and Peace is the Social Justice Arm of the Church.** Usually, D&P has a major campaign during Lent. Due to COVID 19 they were unable to implement this campaign. Parishioners are asked to reach into their hearts, and into their envelope boxes; if there is an unused Development and Peace envelope, to fill it and place it in the collection Basket. Envelopes also available in church foyer and in the Hall. Perhaps this could be your opportunity to support the poor in this time of joy.




