Spiritual Bouquet for Kendrick Beler

Kendrick Beler will be ordained a priest for our diocese July 11. People ask, "What does a new priest need the most? Invariably, the answer is: Money, Books, Vestments or one of the latest electronic gadgets. But what he really needs is **prayer** - for it is the prayer of the people that will sustain him throughout his priesthood. To this end, we at St. Mark will be sending him a **spiritual bouquet**. Some may be asking, "*What is a Spiritual Bouquet?*" Spiritual Bouquets are prayers or devotional acts that someone (the giver) has or will offer for someone else (the recipient). The idea is that each prayer is like a flower, and combined prayers are a bouquet offered to the individual. It can be given to express joy and/or best wishes. *The action may be: a Rosary, Holy Hour, a Mass offered, Days of Fasting, Act of Charity, Special Novenas, or any other spiritual action.*

Over the next few Sundays, we will have a card in the foyer of the church that you can add your prayers to. It is our hope that Kendrick will keep these bouquets close to his heart for the rest of his life
